APPROPRIATE UNIFORM SHOES:

- Velcro or other similar fasteners must be properly and tightly fastened

Enforcement:

The following consequences will be applied for non-compliance:

First non-compliance:

Student will be issued a Dress Code Violation Slip. White copy should be signed by a parent and returned to the Attendance Office.

Second non-compliance:

Student will be issued a Dress Code Violation Slip. White copy should be signed by a parent and returned to the Attendance Office. Parent phone call made by person issuing the Dress Code Violation.

Third non-compliance:

Student will be issued a 3rd Dress Code Violation Slip. White copy should be signed by a parent and returned to the Attendance Office. After School Detention will be assigned—paperwork sent home with student. Students who fail to show for After School Detention will be assigned one day of In-School Suspension.

Additional non-compliance:

Administrative conference with parent.
